ENTRY RULES AND INFORMATION

TO ENTER: Bring your quilts to the location below on Friday April 6, 2012 only. Fill out an entry form in **duplicate** for each quilt.

ENTRY RULES:

1. Quilts must be finished and clean. **Quilts must be free of smoke odor and pet hair.**
2. Item may not have been shown in a previous Umpqua Valley Quilters' Guild show.
3. Not more than **2 entries in one category, per person.** You may enter as many categories as you choose.
4. **All quilts (except Vintage Quilts) over 26", MUST HAVE A FINISHED 4" SLEEVE attached. Sleeve unit must be sewn or pinned top and bottom of the sleeve. If your quilt is more than 95" in length, please place sleeve down from top accordingly, so the quilt will not touch the floor when hung at a 95" length.**
5. Quilts may be offered for sale by owner. Inquire at time of entry.
6. We reserve the right to fold or display your items, according to space availability. Quilts will be hung at the discretion of the Umpqua Valley Quilters' Guild.
7. **All non-UVQ Guild exhibitors will receive a "1-Day Paid Admission" ticket.**
8. Photographs may be taken of quilts entered in the show.
9. A memory DVD will be made of this Quilt Show. All entered quilts or items will be photographed for this DVD unless you elect to exclude your entry.

SKILL LEVEL: In an effort to make competition fair, you may choose your skill level for each entry. Example - you may feel you are an intermediate in piecing, but only a beginning hand quilter. The Specialty Categories are open to all skill levels.

JUDGING: This is not a juried show. Anyone may enter. The quilts will be judged by a certified quilt judge before the opening of the show. Some of the aspects to be judged are workmanship, color & design, general appearance & neatness, and suitability to category.

If a quilt is entered in the wrong category, it will not be judged.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded at the judge' discretion in all skill levels and categories, except Vintage, Special Exhibit, and Display Only. All exhibitors will be entered into a drawing.

LIABILITY: Every effort is made to guarantee the safety of your items.

The Umpqua Valley Quilters' Guild cannot be held responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.

PICK UP: Quilts must be picked up from the Fairgrounds on Sunday, April 15, 2012 between 5:00 & 5:30 pm. You must have your receipt to pick up your quilt.

QUILT HANGING SLEEVE – INSTRUCTIONS

**Important General Notes for Show Quilt Hanging:
Refer to item 4. on “Entry Rules & Information” above.**

Permanent Sleeve Instructions - (binding not yet attached):

1. Select fabric for your quilt sleeve that matches the back of your quilt, or use unbleached muslin.
2. Measure width of quilt along the top edge. Cut sleeve fabric 8 1/2" wide X width of quilt.
3. Sew a narrow hem at each 8 1/2" end of sleeve – turn under 1/2" twice at each end, thus making the sleeve 2" narrower than the cut size.
4. Fold the sleeve in half (**wrong sides together**) to make 4 1/4" wide.
5. Center sleeve to quilt and pin in place at top edge of quilt. As you attach the binding to the quilt, the top edge of the sleeve will be stitched in place. Press.
6. Hand-stitch the lower edge of the sleeve to the **quilt backing only** along the bottom edge. Leave ends open for rod insertion..

Temporary Sleeve Instructions – (quilt & binding completed):

1. Follow steps 1 thru 3 as above.
2. Fold the sleeve in half, (**right sides together**). Stitch 1/4" seam along the raw edge and turn right side out. Press.
3. Center sleeve to quilt and pin in place at **top edge just below binding**. Hand stitch the sleeve through the quilt **backing only** along top and bottom edge of sleeve, leaving ends open for rod insertion.

- 10. **HAND QUILTED** - Any technique.

 - 13. Miniature Quilt, under 24" per side, a-to-scale version of full-size quilt

 - 17. Made by a child, 15 and under.
 - 18. Wall Hanging.
 - 19. Other Items: pillow, table runner, placemat, etc. _____.

 - 21. Vintage Quilts, (before 1950) no judging.
